4.4 **St Margaret's Church request for funding towards replacement of the boiler.**

Cllr. Blundell advised that only £450 was available under S137 and proposed that this be given to St Margaret's Church, seconded by Cllr. Brooker who believed that there would be any parishioners wishing to make a donation personally but unable to do so.

Cllr. Baldwin opposed the payment and suggested £225 as he felt other organisations might make requests before the end of the financial year.

There was considerable discussion on the matter.

Cllr. Baldwin made a counter proposal that £225 be given to St Margaret's Church, seconded by Cllr. Grosvenor.

It was noted that St Margaret's Church had also contacted Shoreham PC and asked for financial support

The Clerk advised that other sections can be used to make payment for specific reasons, as Council has done in the past. This would mean that funds would be taken from Reserve. S137 should only be used if no other section is available.

Cllr. Blundell's proposal was put to the vote, 4 in favour, 2 against Cllrs. Baldwin and Grosvenor.

Cllr. Baldwin's proposal was not put to the vote.

Cllr. Brooker offered to purchase a seat in his father's memory and position that at the crossroads. This would replace the log. Clerk will contact Kent Highways to get permission.

KHS representative contacted the skip company which did not have a licence and the area had been cleared. Clerk was informed the materials are back in the road. Clerk will action KHS.

Council has been invited to register a beacon. Clerk will ascertain if the Jubilee Committee has registered. Concern was expressed that Halstead Parish might not be included in the book which will be presented to HM Queen Elizabeth II.

6.7 It was noted that County Councillor Roger Gough stated at a meeting in Badgers Mount that the site at the end of Badgers Mount Road by the M25 roundabout has been put on the KCC Waste & Minerals list. Clerk will contact Cllr. Gough.

7.1 **FREEDOM OF INFORMATION REQUEST**

Information on Gypsy sites throughout the Sevenoaks District

The information had been circulated and there was considerable discussion on the response. Contents were **noted**.

It was proposed by Cllr. Blundell, seconded by Cllr. Grosvenor and carried unanimously that the Clerk should write to SDC to ascertain further facts about the Hever Road site in Edenbridge: 1. How much income is received from the tenants; 2. Why have the costs of running the site increased so drastically from year one to 2010/11.

It was noted that the Polhill site is managed by Kent County Council.

It was proposed by Cllr. Blundell, seconded by Cllr. Grosvenor and carried unanimously that the Clerk should write to Kent County Council to ascertain facts about the Polhill site. The same questions will be asked as those sent to SDC.

Resolved: The Clerk will write to SDC in relation to Hever Road, Edenbridge Gypsy Site to ascertain income from tenants and an explanation on the increase of running costs.

Resolved: The Clerk will write to KCC in relation to Polhill, Shoreham Gypsy Site to ascertain the same data as originally requested from SDC.
